

FollowTheStar booklets will be available in church (for those who would like them) to read through from 24 December onwards.

Throughout Advent you will find silver and gold stars in church, either in pews or at the back. Everyone will be invited to write a Christmas 'hope, wish or prayer' on a star and to put it into the box provided. In the same way that the wise men must have been filled with hope at the following of the star, everyone will be invited to write a Christmas 'hope, wish or prayer' on a star and to put it into the box provided. The stars will be collected and will hang in the church for the duration of the follow the star campaign, immediately after Christmas Day and up to Epiphany.

#### **Christmas Trees 2018**

Thank you for your support last year by raising a marvellous record £11,503 for 230 trees.

As last year, as in previous years, donations were given to some 50 local parishes and nearly 25 charities.

Due to our dry summer and the heavy demand last Christmas, there will be fewer trees available this year.

As before, the arrangement is for you to make a donation for your tree; half is returned to your parish church with the balance going to the 25 charities. This is a great chance for you to raise funds for improved facilities at your parish church (ie, WC and kitchenette at St Mary of Charity) and some deserving charities at the same time. The traditional Norwegian Spruce and the softer slimmer blue tinge Serbian Spruce are growing and will stay in the ground until collected so they stay fresher for longer.
