The first half of the concert will feature the University String Sinfonia in a programme of music celebrating the English countryside.

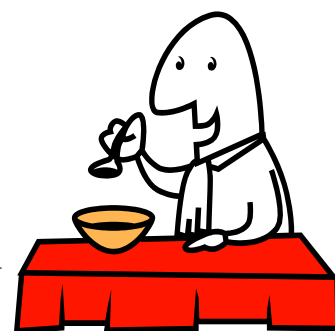

of the church from the first Wednesday in June!

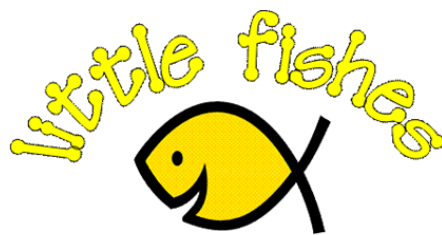

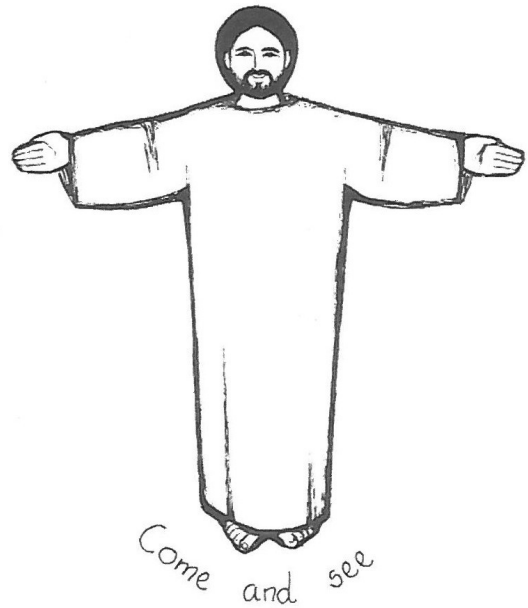
