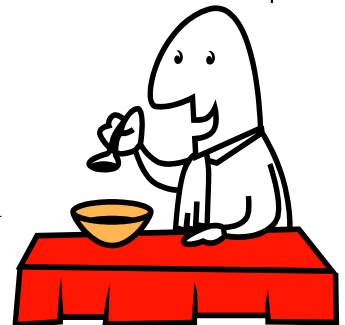

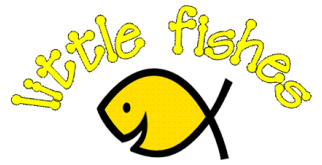

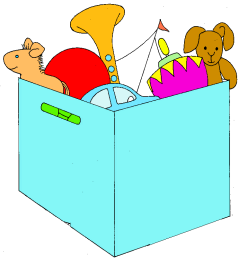


Little Fishes really *does* need your help!
